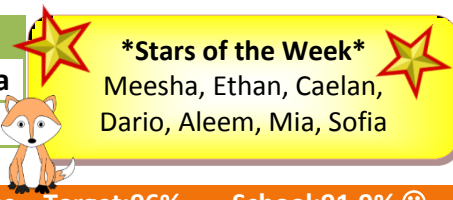

## Sale Water Park Trip

Here is a reminder of the details for Monday's trip:

*On Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> of July the whole school will be heading off to Sale Water Park for a day of kayaking, raft-building, archery, climbing and nature trails.*

*Thank you to the parents who paid the £5 donation and given permission on parent pay. Any parent who has not yet done this MUST do so as soon as possible. Without permission, the water park will not let your child participate in the activities.*

*On the day, we have been told the children will need:*

- **To wear comfortable clothes that can dry quickly (not jeans)**
- **Trainers or comfortable footwear that will stay on their feet (not flip flops)**
- **To wear sun cream and a hat if the weather is hot**
- **A waterproof or warm coat if the weather is cold/rainy**
- **A change of clothes and shoes (for Y2-Y6 only)**
- **A water bottle (Y2- Y6 only)**
- **A rucksack or shoulder bag to carry their own belongings (Y2 – Y6 only)**

*The children in Y2 – Y6 will be taking part in the water activities so will need the extra things in case they get a bit wet!*

*If your child has a school lunch (paid or free) Sarah will provide a school packed lunch. Regular packed lunch children should bring one as normal.*

*Because of the high number of parents wanting to volunteer for the trip, we had to pick names at random. These parents have now been contacted. Thank you to everyone else who wanted to join us.*

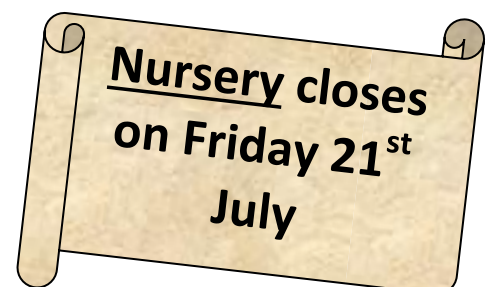
