## Sale Water Park Trip

- A waterproof or warm coat if the weather is cold/rainy
- A change of clothes (for Y2-Y6 only)
- A water bottle (Y2- Y6 only)
- A rucksack or shoulder bag to carry their own belongings (Y2 – Y6 only)

If your child has a school lunch (paid or free) Sarah will provide a school packed lunch. Regular packed lunch children should bring one as normal. Also, we will be in touch about parent volunteers next week.
