# Year 1 Curriculum

## English

- I can read unfamiliar words accurately by blending sounds.
- I can read words of more than one syllable.
- I can spell all 40 high frequency words.
- I can spell days of the week.
- I can leave spaces between words.
- I can punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark.

## Maths

- I can count to and across 100.
- I can count in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s
- I can read and write numbers to 20, as numerals and words.
- Know and use number bonds to 20.
- I can add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.
- I can solve one-step problems using objects and pictorial representations including arrays.
- I can tell and show the time to the hour and half past the hour.

## Science

- I can identify and describe the basic structure of plants.
- I can identify and compare common animals.
- I can identify, name and describe a variety of everyday materials.
- I can observe weather and changes across the four seasons.

## RE

- I can talk about what Christian, Jewish and Muslim people believe.
- I can retell some stories from the Bible.

## PE

- I can master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination, and begin to apply these in a range of activities.
- I can participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending.
